



Enroll in Duo NetID Two-Factor Authentication now!

Each day, the Texas A&M digital network is hit with thousands of malicious attacks. Many of these attacks originate from compromised accounts caused by phishing scams, shared passwords or malware. One of the best weapons against these attacks is multi-factor authentication (Duo).

The [Texas A&M System Regulation 29.01.03](#) requires all students, faculty and staff to enroll in two-factor authentication (Duo). To enhance security and comply with A&M System regulation 29.01.03, faculty and staff are required to enroll no later than **April 15, 2019, at midnight**.

Duo provides a second layer of security to your Texas A&M accounts.

Enrolling is as easy as 1-2-3:



1. Choose your device and download the Duo Mobile app. (We strongly recommend the mobile app as the most user-friendly option.)

3. Remember: Once you sign up, you will need your Duo-enrolled device when you log in to most Texas A&M resources.
